

**GOLD STRUCTURE
CONTINUES**

Val-d'Or, Quebec, June 24, 2010, – Knick Exploration Inc. (TSX-V: KNX) (“Knick Exploration” or “the Company”) has commenced the first step of the second phase exploration program on its flag ship East-West property. Mechanical stripping has begun, centered on its 2009 gold discovery area situated in the eastern part of the property. To date the excavating has extended the surface trace of the 2009 gold bearing structure 70m eastward toward the historic east gold zone. Upon completion of the stripping, a program of diamond drilling (+10,000 meters) will commence.

Highlights from the 2009 discovery area include: drill core intersections of 10.08g/t over 1.45 meter, 21.59g/t over 0.95 meter, 37.13g/t over 0.30 meter; and surface samples of 26.67g/t over 0.90 meter and 38.26g/t over 0.50 meter.

The historic East Zone is situated 150 meters east of the 2009 discovery area. Historic East Zone gold highlights include: 115.07g/t over 2.10 meters, 310.96g/t over 0.80 meter and 303.77g/t over 0.30 meter.

Mechanical stripping initially exposed the 2009 gold discovery area for a strike length of 85 meters and the 2009 drilling also delineated the system to a vertical depth of 75 meters.

Historic East Zone drilling outlined the zone at vertical depths of 15 meters to 250 meters.

The 2009 gold discovery area and the historic East Gold Zone were separated by 150m. The 150m gap between the two gold areas as well as the extensions of systems at deeper depths are being targeted for 2010 infill drilling. This drilling will potentially prove up a +300m strike length and vertical continuity of the gold system at depth.

President's Comments:

That latest stripping clearly indicates the favourable potential of the Eastern Area of the property. High grade gold values obtained from both surface and drilling gives us great expectations for the future of the East-West property. We are extremely pleased with our land position between past-producers Marban Mines and Producers Wesdome Mines. Favorable land position, located among giants, has been the key of many successes and we intend to prove it on the East-West property.
