**GOLD SYSTEM EXPOSED AND TRACED
250 METERS**

Val-d'Or, Quebec, September 16, 2010, – Knick Exploration Inc. (TSX-V: KNX) (“Knick Exploration” or “the Company”) has completed the 2010 program of mechanical stripping on its flagship East-West property. The stripping centered on its 2009 gold discovery on the eastern part of the property has exposed the gold system for 250m. The system is open along strike and depth. The 2010 stripping has closed the gap between the gold system and historic East Gold Zone to less than 100m.

Historic East Zone gold highlights include: 115.07g/t over 2.10 meters, 310.96g/t over 0.80 meter and 303.77g/t over 0.30 meter.

Channel sampling of the newly exposed shearing/veining and mineralization is nearing completion with the majority of samples in various stages of processing. Final results are pending and will be forthcoming late September early October.

The newly excavated gold system will be referred to as the Raven Gold zone in future.

President's Comments:

When mechanical stripping/excavation can be performed it is an incredible asset to the geological advancement of any property toward the discovery and development of a deposit. The information gleaned from this work has and will save time and money in our pursuit of an economic gold deposit. Channel sampling can be equated to horizontal drilling at a fraction of the cost and given the higher density of sampling this leads to better confidence in a gold structures potential.
