## KNICKS' TRECESSON PROJECT ST-NAZAIRE COPPER OCCURRENCE

Val-d'Or, Quebec, February 19, 2013, – Knick Exploration Inc. (TSX-V: KNX) is pleased to report that recently completed **ground geophysics surveys** were **successful** in locating **electromagnetic conductive zones** and **defining a north-northeast trending structure** in the vicinity of the **St-Nazaire Copper** occurrence situated in the **northwest part of Knicks' Trecesson Project**. The **St-Nazaire occurrence** originally discovered in **1987** by **Lac Minerals** when **drill testing** various **electromagnetic targets** assayed **0.94% copper** and **5.98g/t silver** over **20.7m** including **1.82% copper** and **10.32g/t silver** over **7.6m** with associated **anomalous zinc** and **lead** values over the 20.7m intersection(GM46725, p.32).

The **St-Nazaire occurrence** is situated **4.8km north-northeast** of the **Mallach-2 precious and base-metal occurrence** (press release-January 29, 2013). It lies **peripheral** to the **Trecesson Intrusive**, is **hosted in volcanic rocks** and shows **similarities to deposits** in the **Mattagami** and **Quevillon regions** situated 125km north-northeast and 110km east-northeast of the property, respectively.

The **Trecesson property** presently is comprised of **217 claims covering 92 square kilometers**. It is **located 12 km** from the town of **Amos** and approximately **65 km** north northwest of the city of **Val d'Or**. The property is **traversed by paved and all weather gravel roads** making it **accessible year round**.

Gordon N. Henriksen, P.Geo., Vice President of Knick Exploration, is the Company's qualified person as defined by National Instrument 43-101. He has reviewed and approved the contents of this press release.
